Available to any golfer looking for specific instruction with 1 on 1 focus.

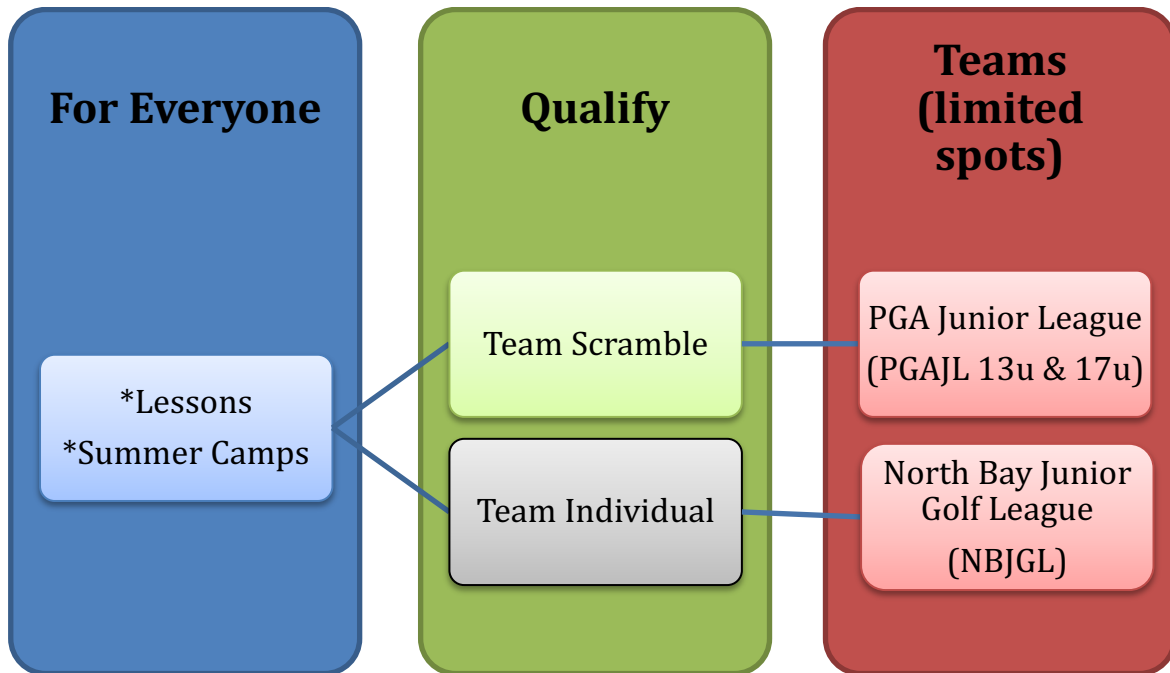

Summer Camps

Summer Camps are designed to promote having fun in the golf club environment by combining golf skills, social interaction, and physical exercise. This year's camps will feature basic golf techniques using games and activities that include the PGA core values of honor, integrity and etiquette. Play Programs – AKA Team Petaluma...



There are 2 types of teams: team competition and individual team competitions. PGA Junior League is a two-person scramble 9-hole format; there are teams for ages 8-17 in the programs. The North Bay Junior Golf League is for individual play, 18-hole formats. There will be opportunities to Qualify for one or more teams on the above list.

The Teams will be formed based on qualifying scores. There will be limited spaces on each team based on the league and how many available playing spots there are.

PGA Junior League 13u (Ages 8-13):

(Players can be no older than 13 as of July 31st, 2023. 8-year-old Juniors with golf experience may be considered based on acceptable skill levels. The PGA Junior League is **not** a beginner program, and players are expected to exhibit basic abilities to play golf before enrolling).

This popular PGA Junior League program is back for an eighth year. The fee for the year is **\$399** per junior golfer. All PGA Junior League fees include team uniforms (home and away collared shirts), weekly practices, greens fees, drawstring bag, hat, championship fees, bag tags, year-end Club Championship, and golf instruction, including golf rules and etiquette.

All league team members practice weekly and play scheduled matches against neighboring clubs throughout the season. The competition format offers a 9-hole, two-person scramble format. The nine holes are split into three matches of three holes each. Weekly practice sessions may include an optional short instructional clinic, driving range and/or chip & pitch time, and either a skills challenge, golf game, or interactive play. Practice days will be held on Wednesdays and another day TBD. All interclub matches are generally held on Sundays, and occasionally on Saturdays. The regular season runs from May through the end of July, This year some regular season games will also be played in August. .

PGA Junior League 17u (Ages 14-17):

This year PG&CC added the “17-under” age group of PGAJL to our Junior Golf Program. With this addition, we now have three separate competitive Team opportunities to offer our junior golfers. As they grow, their skills progress, and their choices now expand to challenge their golfing abilities.

PGAJL 17u competition is similar to 13u except the tee boxes are set further back (3 different sets of tees) to accommodate juniors’ growth in age and ability.

These are “full field host” dates as all League Teams will play at each site, with all but one being Shot Gun starts. Two of these Match Dates will be Stroke Play and be part of All-Star Qualifier Competitions. All-Star selections will be made on July 10. Some All-Star Events will be held in July while 2 other regular season dates continue to be played.</p>		

North Bay Junior Golf League (Team Play):

(Ages 13-17; Must Qualify)

North Bay Junior Golf League (NBJGL) fields a team that plays competitive matches using an 18-hole individual stroke play format with each Club fielding 6-member teams. The top four scores of each team of six will record a cumulative team score for each match.

Although only six players can compete at one time, PG&CC teams typically include more than six players to ensure a full team at each match. Fee per player for the North Bay Junior Golf League is **\$250.***

**Juniors enrolled in any PGAJL Team pay only for NBJGL uniform. (Most 14-17 yrs juniors will also enroll in the PGAJL 17u Team, so will only pay for the NBJGL uniform shirt/hat cost, which are very reasonable.)*

PG&CC Junior Membership (Ages 12-18):

PG&CC Bylaws allow a limited Junior Membership group of no more than **15** juniors who are at least 13 years old and have not yet reached their 18th birthday (or graduated high school). Junior Members must demonstrate to our Golf Pro that they can play capably and unsupervised prior to being approved for membership. For \$70 a month dues, each Junior Member is entitled to:

- Unlimited golf privileges (with a few exceptions)
- Priority into PGA Junior League
- Priority into North Bay Junior Golf League
- Access to play in Junior Tournaments
- Unlimited use of Practice Facilities

Junior Club Championship (Ages 9-17):

PG&CC will climax this exciting junior golf season with a celebration of skills and golfing friendships. Any junior golfer of eligible age who participated in any of this year's junior programs will be eligible to play in this event.

Flights and pairings will be determined by team coaches based on the number and range of players interested in competing within given levels. Flights of play will be organized to include multiple hole events as well as an 18-hole Championship Flight. Championship Flight participants will vie for the enviable title of PG&CC Junior Club Championship. Awards for all flights in this tournament as well as the entire junior program for the year, will be awarded at the conclusion of this event.
