Available to any golfer looking for specific instruction with 1 on 1 focus.

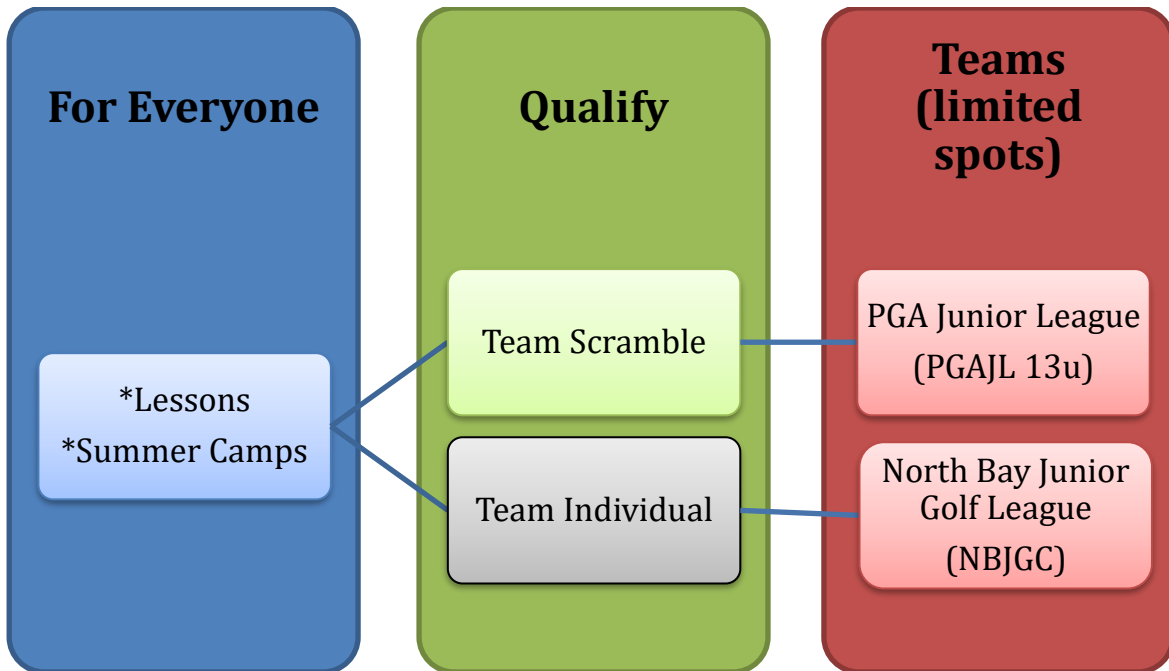

### **Summer Camps**

Summer Camps are designed to promote having fun in the golf club environment by combining golf skills, social interaction, and physical exercise. This year's camps will feature basic golf techniques using games and activities that include the PGA core values of honor, integrity and etiquette. Each camp session includes three days a week, Tuesday through Thursday from 8:30am to 12:00pm. Total cost per junior will be \$300 for each camp (Please contact Patrick to sign up)

## Play Programs – AKA Team Petaluma...



There are 2 types of teams: team competition and individual team competitions. PGA Junior League is a two person scramble format; there are teams for all ages in the programs. The North Bay Junior Golf League is for individual play formats. There will be opportunities to Qualify for one or multiple teams on the above list.

The Teams will be formed based on qualifying scores. There will be limited spaces on each team based on the league and how many available playing spots there are.

**4 – PGA Junior League (Ages 8-13; can be no older than 13 as of July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021. Juniors with golf experience may be considered based on acceptable skill levels.)**

This highly anticipated and extremely popular PGA Junior League is back for a seventh year. Traveling league members practice weekly and play several scheduled matches against neighboring clubs throughout the season. The regular season runs from May through the end of July. Post-season play begins in August. Cost for the season is \$350 per junior. The calendar of practices and competition are listed on the following chart/page.

Weekly practice sessions include an optional instructional clinic, driving range time, and either a skills challenge, golf game, or interactive play. Practice days will be held on Wednesdays and another day TBD. All interclub matches are held on either Saturdays or Sundays.

PGA Junior League fees include team uniforms (home and away collared shirts), weekly practices, greens fees, drawstring bag, hat championship fees, bag tags, year-end Club Championship, and instruction.

PGA Junior League is **not** a beginner program and players are expected to exhibit basic abilities to play before enrolling. The competition format offers a 9-hole, two-person scramble format where the nine holes are split into three matches of three holes each. All juniors play at least one three-hole match per round and , when not playing, are expected to help teammates align putts, rake traps and participate in strategic shot selection.

## 5 – North Bay Junior Golf League Team Play (Ages 14-17 and currently enrolled in high school)

North Bay Junior Golf League (NBJGL) Team Play fields a team that plays competitive matches using an 18-hole individual stroke play format using the top four scores of each team of six to record a team score during each match. Although only six players can compete at one time, PG&CC teams typically include more than six players to ensure a full team at each match. Cost for the North Bay League is \$250.

## 7 – PG&CC Junior Membership (Ages 12-18)

PG&CC Bylaws allow a limited Junior Membership group of no more than 15 juniors who are at least 13 years old and have not yet reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday. Junior Members must be able to demonstrate that they can play capably and unsupervised prior to being permitted to join. For \$60 a month, each Junior Member is entitled to:

- Unlimited golf privileges with few exceptions
- Priority into PGA Junior League
- Priority into North Bay Jr. Golf League
- Access to play in Junior Tournaments
- Unlimited use of Practice Facilities

## 8 – North Bay Junior Golf League Match Play (Ages 14-17) *(Exceptions made based on skill level determined by scores & coaches)*

Top players in the North Bay Jr. Golf League will have the opportunity to qualify for Match Play. Participants must have played in at least 2 post able events to qualify for post season Match Play. Match Play events are listed below for those North Bay Junior Golf League members.

Flights and pairings will be determined by team coaches based on the number and range of players interested in competing within given levels. Flights of play will be organized to include multiple hole events as well as an 18-hole Championship Flight. Championship Flight participants will vie for the enviable title of PG&CC Junior Club Championship. Awards for all flights in this tournament as well as the entire junior program for the year, will be awarded at the conclusion of this event.
